

DRESS CODE

While fashions change, the reason for being in school does not. Students are in school to learn. Any fashion (dress, accessory, or hairstyle) that disrupts the educational process or presents a safety risk will not be permitted. Personal expression is permitted within these general guidelines.

Students are required to wear the school uniform every day. The colors are as follows:

Bottoms

**K-8th Grade: Khaki
Dark blue,
Black**

K-8th Grade: Blue, White

Black

Polo Shirt (plain color, no graphics)

****All shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skorts must not be any shorter than 1 inch above the knee.***

****NO HOODIES may be worn at any time in the school!**

Unacceptable Clothing resulting in parent phone call:

Hoodies, open toe shoes, flip flops, heels, bandannas, dangling earrings, shirts and sweaters with graphics, caps, **hair dye**, drooping/sagging pants, distractive jewelry (chains, silly bands, loom bracelets), make up

***Jewelry items will be confiscated and returned to the child at the end of the day. A repeated offence will result in confiscation and a parent will be required to collect the item.**

If a student has selected a manner of appearance that is disruptive to the educational process or presents a risk to themselves or others, they may be removed from the educational setting. See code of conduct.
