The school's college prep curriculum teaches 120 minutes of English Language Arts and 90 minutes of Math each day, and emphasizes Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math with a one-to-one laptop program for all students. In addition to core subjects, students participate in Art, PE, Social-Emotional Learning (SEL), Technology, and Writing classes during the school day.

Extracurricular activities include sports, clubs, field trips, and school events. STEAM Academy supports families with free tutoring, school supplies, and on-site counseling services.

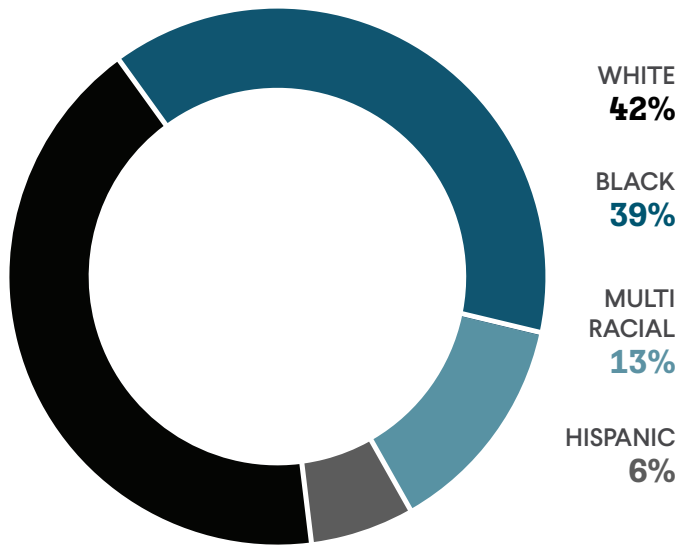

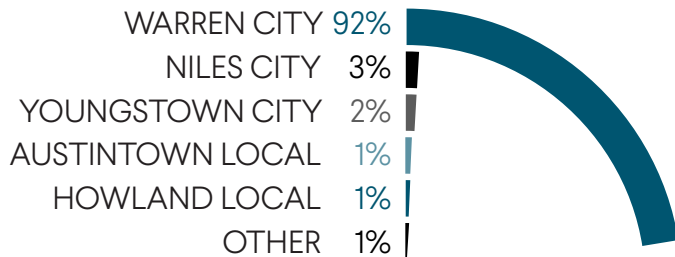

DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

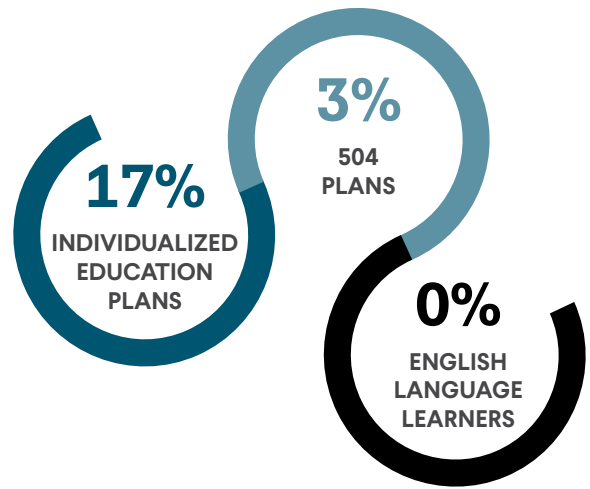

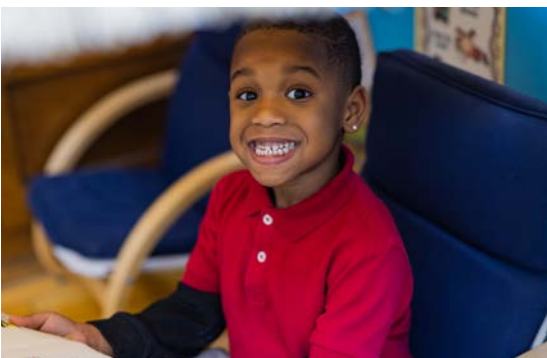

- Overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above in Math on state tests will increase by 15%

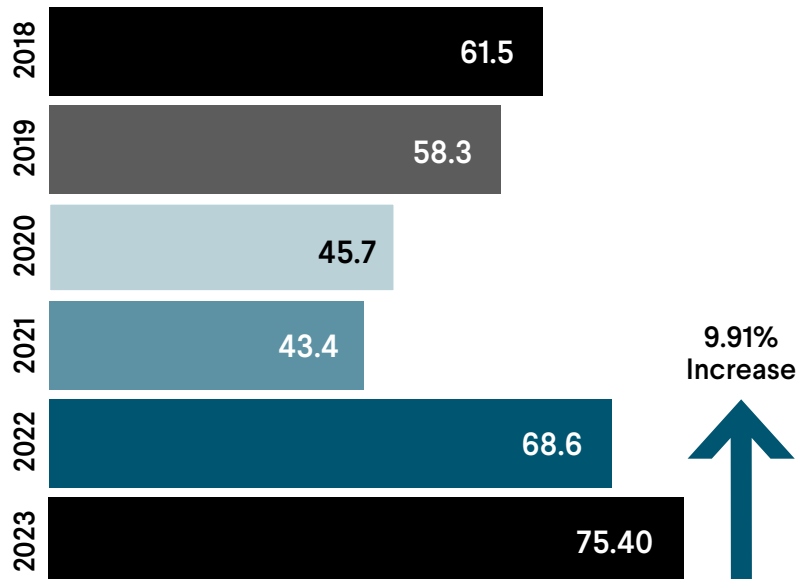
